COURSE OUTLINE

COURSE TITLE: Art History and Related Study 1

COURSE NUMBER: ART 211

SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS: 2 (32 hours for one semester)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students make their proposal for their related study based on personal interest as it relates to the development of their creative coursework. Students begin their research in the early part of the semester. Firstly they visit local artists who feature in their study, interview them, analyse works of art and collect images. Ongoing discussion, research and documentation are made for the study throughout this semester.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

- 1) To identify the theme for the related study and ideas
- 2) To write and send the Written Study Proposal to Cambridge
- 3) To identify local artists for the study and to start visiting, interviewing and documenting visual and written findings.
- 4) To develop research skills.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

(Learning Outcomes)

The written study proposal will be sent to Cambridge at the beginning of November. Written and Visual documentation on visits to local artists will have been made.

CONTENT:

1. Explanation of requirements for written study.

2. Reading of past students written studies.
3. Group discussions on students' ideas for theme and how that would relate to the development of their coursework. Research begins.
4. Students bring research to class to share and discuss and use the time for further research and documentation.
5. Written Study Proposal in finished and sent to England.
6. Research and documentation continues with advice from the tutor.
