Graduates may be employed in: Agricultural Services, Crop Management, Dairy Management, Farm Management, Farm Production, International Agribusiness, Production Horticulture and Pastoral Systems. Graduates will be able to perform a leadership role within their industry and their community and be able to communicate effectively with employees, employers, clients and service professionals.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Associate Degree Programme is designed to produce graduates with the necessary knowledge, skills and ability to undertake job responsibilities as senior technicians, middle management personnel, agricultural teachers, commercial farmers, farm managers and also provides a base for advanced agricultural studies as the Baccalaureate Degree level. During the two-year tenure, students will receive classes in Science and production courses, as well as practical agriculture and farming activities. The programme focus will be to use modern scientific techniques with a business approach to agriculture and farming.

## GRADUATION

Once students complete the required course work and have earned the applicable credits, they must fill out a Request to Graduate form which is available online for download or from the Admissions Office. They may attend the T.A. Marryshow Community College graduation ceremony as long as they are eligible to graduate.
