YOUR CAREER

Nurses work in many community settings such as clinics, health departments, physician offices, outreach programs, and even churches. Educational settings include public elementary schools, colleges and universities, and community health programs. For the nurse who likes independence and individual contact with patients and families, homecare is also a growing field. Occupational health nurses ensure that health care is available to the employees of various businesses and industries. Nurses work for insurance companies to review benefit claims. Some nurses work for pharmaceutical companies to get information on new drugs to healthcare providers and patients. More nurses are working on research to improve healthcare practices

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Associate Degree in Nursing prepares graduates to provide and manage client-care and to become members within the discipline of nursing. Intrinsic to the three roles of the nurse- provider of care, manager of care and member of the discipline are the eight core components of nursing practice. The eight core components are professional behaviors, nursing process, communication, clinical decision making, care interventions, teaching/learning, collaboration and managing care. These core components are introduced, developed, and built upon throughout the curriculum. The curriculum is organized around a clearly defined conceptual framework, and combines general education and nursing courses. The nursing courses correlate classroom and clinical instruction in a variety of community agencies.

GRADUATION

Once students complete the required course work and have earned the applicable credits, they must fill out a Request to Graduate form which is available online for download or from the Admissions Office . They may attend the T.A. Marryshow Community College graduation ceremony as long as they are eligible to graduate.
