- 16 years of age and over

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

A Cultural Studies degree program explores and analyzes images, texts, art works and sign systems. Graduates of such programs are recruited for work in the cultural sector (publishing, the media, arts and cultural institutions) for teaching, study, and research.

GRADUATION

Once students complete the required course work and have earned the applicable credits, they must fill out a Request to Graduate form which is available online for download or from the Admissions Office. They may attend the T.A. Marryshow Community College graduation ceremony as long as they are eligible to graduate.
