

INVIGILATORS PLEASE READ TO CANDIDATES BEFORE ALL EXAMINATIONS

RULES DURING EXAMINATIONS

- 1) Examinees should NOT talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates in any form whatsoever (including non-verbal communication) once they have entered the examination room, unless through the invigilator.
- 2) Candidates should have their own calculators (if permitted for the exam), pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, T-sets and stencils. Calculators should be non-programmable and non-graphical.
- 3) Examinees should NOT bring unauthorised material and equipment, such as, pieces of paper, notebooks, MP3 players, PDA's, calculator cases/instruction leaflets, laptops, pagers and bags to the examination room. **Pencil or glasses cases should not be on desks.** CELL PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN EXAMINATION ROOMS.
- 4) Candidates should not be involved in any unfair or dishonest practice before, during or after the examination which will give them an unfair advantage.
- 5) Examinees will not be allowed extra time when they arrive late for an examination.
- 6) Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination room before thirty (30) minutes have elapsed in the examination.
- 7) Examinees should not turn over the examination paper until instructed to do so by the Chief Invigilator.
- 8) Candidates should cease all writing at the conclusion of an examination. The Chief Invigilator may seize the papers of candidates who fail to observe this requirement.
- 9) Examinees must NOT leave the examination room with question papers, answer booklets, scrap paper or any other used or unused materials.
