VACANCY

The T. A. Marryshow Community College invites applications from suitably qualified persons to teach a part-time course in Molecular Diagnostics as an Adjunct Lecturer in the School of Continuing Education.

Course Description

The Course, AHT109: Molecular Diagnostics, will provide students with a basic introduction to molecular diagnostic techniques which is the process of identifying a disease by studying molecules, such as proteins, DNA, and RNA, in a tissue or fluid. The students will learn about DNA structure and chemistry, as well as have the opportunity to develop skills in molecular techniques. Principles and interpretation of results of a variety of molecular techniques will be covered.

At the end of the Course, Students should be able to demonstrate knowledge of the fundamentals of molecular diagnostics; practise specimen collection and handling; practise procedure principles; and select clinical applications.

The Candidate

The successful candidate should have:

- At least a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent Professional Certification in Molecular Biology, Clinical Biochemistry, Genetic Biotechnology or a related area of specialization.
- Have practical experience with PCR analysis and Genetics.
- Have excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Experience in teaching at the tertiary level will be an asset.
