## F.A.Q (Frequently Asked Questions)

What is an internship?

•It is the application of skills learnt in the classroom in a work environment. It consists of 240 hours of on the job training, completed over a 6 week period.

#### How to prepare for Internship?

- ✓ Start securing professional wear early.
- ✓ Ensure that tools & Health & Safety gears are purchased before the commencement of internship.
- ✓ Complete your resume and certify.

## Is Internship a graduation requirement for my programme?

- ✓ SAAT- Mandatory for all programmes
- ✓ SCE- Based on placement availability
- ✓ SASPS Office Administration & 
  Physical Education

#### Do I need to register for Internship?

✓ . Yes; there is a \$30 registration fee

#### What are the prerequisites for Internship?

- ✓ Must have 85% class attendance.
- ✓ Must possess a G.P.A of 2.0 or higher.
- ✓ Must not be in violation of the Disciplinary Code, Student Handbook 2009-2011.
- ✓ Must pass all courses.
- ✓ Must display good deportment during tenure at the College.

## Who should you consult regarding your eligibility for internship?

✓ The Chair of your Department.

#### Can I choose my internship placement?

✓ No; Students are placed based on their competence and companies requests/wishes.

# What happens If I do not meet the requirements for internship & it is mandatory for my programme?

✓ The student will not be able to graduate. When do I start my internship?

- ✓ SASPS June

#### Do I get paid at the end of my internship?

Internship providers are <u>NOT</u> required to provide financial compensation to College interns.
