Grenada Campus Analysis – CAPE 2026

The T.A. Marryshow Community College wishes to announce that it has received the 2026 Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE) preliminary results from the Caribbean Examinations Council. In this regard, officials at the College are currently reviewing and analysing the performances of the candidates who sat the examinations in May – June 2026. It was noted that **in 2026** there was **an overall pass rate of 94.29 %** while there was **an overall pass rate of 93.52 %** in 2025.

The **CAPE 2026 Unit 1 percentage pass** was 92.77 % as compared to 92.92 % in 2025. **The 2026 Unit 1 CAPE Examination results** have revealed that a **total of fifty-five (55) Grade One's** were achieved in eleven (11) subject areas compared to fifty-four (54) Grade One's in thirteen (13) subject areas in 2025. A Grade One denotes excellent performance by students. **Grade One's were obtained in the Unit 1 2026 CAPE Examinations** in: Accounting (1) Applied Mathematics (1), Biology (9), Caribbean Studies (5) Chemistry (7), Communication Studies (3), Environmental Science (3), Law (1), Physics (5), Pure Mathematics (19) and Sociology (1).

There were **seven (7) subjects** for the **2026 Unit 1 CAPE Examinations** which recorded 100 % passes, namely, Applied Mathematics, Caribbean Studies, Economics, Environmental Science, Geography, Literatures in English and Spanish. **Other 2026 Unit 1 CAPE subjects with commendable performances were:** Communication Studies (98.41 %) Law (90.63 %) Management of Business (91.18 %) Physics (95.45 %) Pure Mathematics (95.24 %) and Sociology (96.77%).

The **CAPE 2026 Unit 2** percentage pass was 95.80 % as compared to 94.46 % in 2025. The **2026 Unit 2 CAPE Examination** results have shown that **sixty-six (66) Grade One's** were achieved in thirteen (13) subject areas compared to **fifty-one (51) Grade One's** in ten (10) subject areas in 2025. **Grade One's in 2026 Unit 2 CAPE Examinations** were obtained in: Accounting (1), Applied Mathematics (2), Biology (11), Chemistry (10), Entrepreneurship (2), French (2), Geography (2), Law (2), Management of Business (5), Physics (5), Pure Mathematics (22), Sociology (1) and Spanish (1).

One hundred percent passes for the **2026 Unit 2 CAPE Examinations** were recorded in ten (10) units, namely, Applied Mathematics, Entrepreneurship, Environmental Science, French, Geography, Literatures in English, Physics, Pure Mathematics, Sociology and Spanish. **Other 2026 Unit 2 CAPE subjects with commendable performances were:** Accounting (93.75%), Biology (96.43 %), Chemistry (94.12 %), Economics (92.59 %) and Management of Business (95.24 %).

In 2026, the **total number of subject entries was 1061**, of which 284 were males and 777 were females. The male pass rate was 95.75 % whereas the female was 93.40 %.

A total of 385 students from the T.A. Marryshow Community College **wrote the 2026 CAPE Examinations** in twenty-one **(21) subject** areas, compared to **a total of 359 students** in twenty-one **(21) subject** areas in 2025.
